



Thank You Card

- thank you card
- pencil
- pen or marker

1. Start writing in pencil. You'll go over your note in pen or marker once you're done writing.
2. You can write on both sides of the inside, but normally people only write on one.
3. Start with "Dear _____," and fill in the name of the person you're writing to.
4. Say thank you for something nice that person did for you. Maybe it's something as simple as being a good friend or cleaning your room for you.
5. End your card with "Love," "Sincerely," "Peace," or "Your friend".
6. Sign your name.
7. Go over the card in pen.
