



Ojo de Dios (God's Eye)

- Yarn
- 2 popsicle sticks

1. Take 2 popsicle sticks or bamboo skewers and make an X with them.
2. Take out your yarn and wrap it 5 times around the cross bar of the X in one direction.
3. Wrap the yarn 5 times in the other direction so the yarn makes a cross with the yarn you've already wrapped. Straighten out your popsicle sticks if they are crooked.
4. Wrap the string around the back of one of the sticks. Bring the string around the front of the stick, and then across the front of the stick next to it on the left (counterclockwise).
5. Bring the string around the back of the second stick. Then wrap it around the front of the second stick and the front of the third stick (one to the left).
6. Repeat that process, always moving one stick to the left. You never need to turn your sticks over or change directions. Lay the yarn right next to the last piece of yarn so the yarn doesn't overlap.
7. If your yarn runs out, take a new piece of yarn and wrap it around the end of the old one a few times so it holds. Then continue with your pattern.
8. Once you start to run out of stick to cover, take the end of the yarn and wrap it loosely around one of the sticks. Tie a double knot around the stick and snip off the end of the string.
9. You've finished your Ojo de Dios!

How do you normally fasten two objects together?

- Glue
- A tied knot
- A stapler
- A safety pin

Try and wiggle the two sticks of your God's Eye. The don't move very easily—they hold strong.

You didn't use anything to fasten them together like glue or a stapler. We didn't even tie a knot until the very end!

Using a crossover pattern to weave string isn't just strong—it's also beautiful!
